

Missing Person Case Leads To Search Of Seymour Land

SEYMOUR, Conn. - Police investigating the case of a man missing since 2004 are excavating at private land in Seymour.

A missing person report was filed on William Smolinski in August 2004, and the FBI has taken over the investigation.

Several police investigators recently developed investigative leads in this case and began searching private land on Bungay Road in Seymour for evidence of a crime, police said.

The FBI, State Police Major Crime Squad Detectives and Shelton and Seymour police started searching the land Friday.

The landowner is cooperating and has no involvement in the investigation, police said.

Investigators continue to search the property Monday, police said.

The FBI, Connecticut State Police and Seymour and Shelton police are continuing this investigation.
